

8 Principles of Healing from Acts 3-4 **by Jay Judson**

1. See need and listen to diagnosis with compassionate LOVE and faith. Acts 3:4

2. Tell stories of healing from either Bible or real life to build faith.

3. Realize who you are, a child of God, and what you have in Christ. "Faith comes by hearing the word of God. Rom. 10:17. Read every verse on our Identity in Christ I realize that it is not my own righteousness or holiness. Acts 3:12.
4. Thank God that He hears and that He sees sickness. Lay hands on sick and anoint them with oil. Mark 6:13, James 5:17. Ask Jesus' Kingdom to come into their body as it is in Heaven. Matt. 6:10. In heaven there is no sickness, pain or sadness. Rev. 21:4
5. Command the sickness or pain to leave. Acts 3:6. Express that you are not talking to God but to the sickness and not commanding God but the mountain in the Mighty Name of Jesus. Mark 11:23-24. Speaking to inanimate objects like cancer or broken bones is the big shift in my understanding on this. Mark 11:12-25.
6. Ask or help sick to do something that they could not do before. Acts 3:7. Ask if they are 60% better or 20% better. Do not give up until they give up. Never blame the sick for not being healed. John 9:3, Rom. 8:1. If their is blame then blame yourself.
7. Proclaim the Good News. Acts 3:13
8. If healing does not come immediately, command the sickness to leave or be healed 2 or 3 times. Mark 8:22-24, Matt. 4:39

What my friends and I learn a few years ago was to command sicknesses to leave. They love to anoint people with oil and lay hands on the sick. Early Baptists in the Sandy Creek Revival in North Carolina practiced this and saw a lot of healing.

It doesn't really matter if people are healed or not because they emotionally feel better after we pray for them like that with faith. Christ and the Apostles primarily healed the sick in homes of the lost and in dark places.

We have seen hundreds healed once. We seen thousands NOT healed. I used to be a very strong opponent of "weirdo healers" but then I was financially broke and desperately needed Jesus power among the sick in Burma. As the big rich American I was asked to pay for too many hospital stays and operations in Burma and God had me in a good and humble place to ask for more Holy Spirit power. Healing the sick is like lifting weights. Don't start lifting 150 pounds we start with 10 therefore maybe start praying for headaches and small things before moving on to cancer or resurrections.

A lot of Baptists have let strange faith healers on TV scare them away from becoming more Christ like. Jesus did not just proclaim salvation but He also healed the sick as He commanded His disciples to do. A lot of Baptists spend a lot of their prayer meetings getting requests for prayer and Pastors often visit hospitals but they do not "Command" sicknesses to leave.
